**You can make any group special with us**

**1<sup>st</sup> day: Arrival to Prague airport Ruzyne and visit the Prague Castle.**

- Upon arrival meet and greet our professional local guide
- Transfer the guests with luxury bus to Prague Castle Area, and the bus continue with luggage to the hotel.
- **Band of 3 musicians** welcoming the guests at the **Strahov Terrace**, where a welcome drink will be served in **Czech Crystal glasses** (that the guest will keep afterwards as souvenir)
- After the welcome drink; exclusive visit of the **Strahov Monastery**

*This monastery is situated on the way to the Prague Castle. The Strahov Library is one of the most beautiful historical libraries in Europe and among the most flawless in point of style. Here is the architectural organisation of space, which at once attracts the notice of visitors, then, the painted decoration, the original furnishing above all the wealth of manuscripts and books assembled here. The library holds about 130,000 volumes.*



- After the tour, **lunch in typical restaurant located in the same area**, where the guests can enjoy typical Czech cuisine with Czech beer, or international cuisine accompanying with tasty Czech wines.
- After lunch, visit of the **Prague castle** (4hrs) with entrance to the Royal Palace, St. Vitus Cathedral and Golden lane.

**Prague Castle tour**

*This tour begins at the Archbishop's Palace in renaissance style with a rococo facade and continues to the Hradčany hall, the entrance to the Castle, where we will visit*



*St. Vitus cathedral which gothic construction begun in 1344. The visit continues inside the Royal Palace, which was the seat of the princes and later kings of Bohemia until the 16th century. After a short walk through the Castle's courtyards we will enter in St. George's Basilica, founded by Vratislav I before 921, and later on we will reach the "Golden Lane" with its small houses built into the late 16th century Castle's fortifications. Coming out of the Golden Lane we will go along Jiřská street where is the Lobkowitz Palace, built after 1570 and rebuilt in the later half of the 17th century. Jiřská street ends at a gateway from the 13th-16th century leading to the Old Castle Steps at the bottom of which the tour ends.*

- After the excursion transfer back to the hotel
- Check in and time to refresh
- **Welcome diner** at the hotel
- Overnight.

**2<sup>nd</sup> day: morning: working and fun: in the afternoon.**

- Buffet breakfast at the hotel
- Half-day meeting: including coffee break and buffet lunch at the hotel.
- After lunch, meet our local guide at the hotel reception.

➤ Short visit the **Old Town**

**The Old-Town Square** is one of the most beautiful and complete middle age market squares in the world. It is said to be the oldest in Europe. Due to the historical role it is one of the most prominent cultural squares of Prague surrounded by noble houses of all different styles as well as the Old Town hall with the famous Astronomical Clock, which is one of the Prague's number one attractions. There are many legends to tell about its origins.



The monument of mister Jan Hus in the middle of the square erected in 1915 is also not to forget – since Jun Hus was the greatest personality in the spiritual life of medieval Bohemia.

➤ After the Old Town visit, we continue to **Estate Theatre,**

The Theatre where Amadeus Mozart himself conducted the world premiere of his **Don Giovanni** in 1787

The Theatre of the Estates is one of the most beautiful historic theatre buildings in Europe. The aristocrat František Antonín Count Nostitz Rieneck, fired by a desire to enhance the charm of his native city and the minds of his fellow citizens, had this edifice built. It took not



two years to construct and the theatre was officially opened in 1783 with a first performance of the tragedy *Emilia Galotti* by Lessing



- **Exclusive visit:** of the backstage of the theatre. Welcome drink will be served, and followed by **Don Giovanni performance.**
- After transfer by **Historical tram** which is always a success, incl. a glass of champagne and accordionist player, to the restaurant
- **Farewell diner** in Luxury restaurant, with piano player, or small orchestra.
- After diner transfer back to the hotel with bus
- Overnight

**3<sup>rd</sup> day: departure.**

- Buffet breakfast at the hotel
- Check out from the hotel
- Meet our local guide at hotel reception
- Transfer with luxury bus to the airport
- Departure home with unforgettable memories from their visit

**Other possible performance:**

Visit **Villa Bertramka** – W.A.Mozart memorial, exposition and Mozart gift shop, followed by private **Mozart concert**

The Villa Bertramka is the most significant Prague place connected with the name of one of the greatest world composers - Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart. A former vineyard manor house from the turn of the 17th century became in 1784 the property of the singer Josefina Duskova and the pianist, pedagogue and composer Frantisek Xaver Dusek. They, most probably, deserve credit for staging of Mozart's operas *Die Entfuehrung aus dem Serail* and *The Marriage of Figaro* in Prague and for inviting the author to Prague. Here in the idyllic environment of Bertramka Mozart finished the score of *Giovanni* shortly before its

memorable first night on October 29, 1787. At Bertramka Mozart also composed the concert aria *Bella mia fiamma*, addio and dedicated it to Mrs. Duskova. Mozart called his stays at Bertramka the most beautiful moments of his short and eventful life.
