2 nights / 3 days

The Czech Republic, heart of Europe, has become one of the most visited countries of Europe, with high-quality services whose offer is far greater than that required by ordinary travelers. It can now satisfy even the most sophisticated among them. Though small in size, the country has a wealth of natural sceneries, fine architecture, and a rich cultural life. Culture and history are two phenomena that are literally omnipresent in the Czech Republic. This is probably why the country is ideal for incentive tourism and for creating an unforgettable atmosphere.

You can make any group special with us

1st day: Arrival to Prague airport Ruzyne and visit the Prague Castle.

- Upon arrival meet and greet our professional local guide
- Transfer the guests with luxury bus to Prague Castle Area, and the bus continue with luggage to the hotel.
- **Band of 3 musicians** welcoming the guests at the **Strahov Terrace**, where a welcome drink will be served in **Czech Crystal glasses** (that the guest will keep afterwards as souvenir)
- After the welcome drink; **lunch in typical restaurant**, where the guests can enjoy typical Czech cuisine with Czech beer, or international cuisine accompanying with tasty Czech wines.
- After lunch, visit of the **Prague castle** (4hrs) with entrance to the Royal Palace, St. Vitus Cathedrale and Golden lane.
- After the excursion transfer back to the hotel
- Check in and time to refresh
- **Welcome diner** at the hotel
- Overnight.

Prague Castle tour

This tour begins at Loretto Square in the Castle's district. This is one of the most beautiful squares in Prague. It dates back to the first quarter of the 18th century. From this square we will enjoy a walking tour to the Archbishop's Palace in renaissance style with a rococo facade and continues to the Hradčany hall, the entrance to the Castle, where we will visit St. Vitus cathedral which gothic construction begun in 1.344. The visit continues inside the Royal Palace, which was the seat of the princes and later kings of Bohemia until the 16th century. After a short walk through the Castle's courtyards we will enter in St. George's Basilica, founded by Vratislav I before 921, and later on we will reach the "Golden Lane" with its small houses built into the late 16th century Castle's fortifications. Coming out of the Golden Lane we will go along Jiřská street where is the Lobkowitz Palace, built after 1.570 and rebuilt in the later half of the 17th century. Jiřská street ends at a gateway from the 13th-16th century leading to the Old Castle Steps at the bottom of which the tour ends.



2nd day: morning: working and fun: in the afternoon.

- Buffet breakfast at the hotel
- Half-day meeting: including coffee break and buffet lunch at the hotel.
- After lunch, meet our local guide at the hotel reception.
- Visit the old town as **City rally**

An interactive tour of old Prague. The guests receive a quiz on Prague and Bohemia history. On the route they meet various figures, who ask questions about their lives - W.A.Mozart, A. Dvorak, Rabbi Löw, Charles IV, soldier Svejek, Franz Kafka. And at the end the winner will be recompensed by small gift at dinner.



- After the game free time for shopping
- By own return to the hotel
- Evening, transfer by **Historical tram** which is always a success, incl. a glass of champagne and accordionist player, to the restaurant



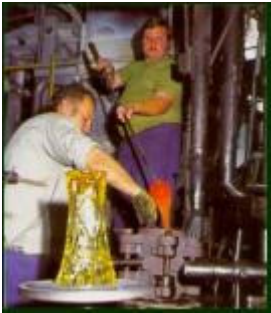
- **Farewell diner** in Luxury restaurant, with piano player, or small orchestra.
- After diner transfer back to the hotel with bus
- Overnight

3rd day: departure.

Other possible activities:

➤ **Glass Making Factories:**



Glass making factories - for example at Nizbor About 50 km west of Prague, in a picturesque valley of the Berounka River is located one of the small family glasswork of Nizbor a specialized factory for the hand made cut Czech crystal 24% lead glass. It was the 18th century - the period of renaissance when in the year 1745, Petr Ruckl, the man who

made an indelible mark in the history of glassmaking was born. He was the first Bohemian born member of the Swiss clan of master glass crafters and the clan name of Ruckl

has since become inextricably associated with the traditional excellence in what is known worldwide as Bohemia Glass. During your visit to the works you will see the glassblowers and glasscutters at work.

Some time at leisure will be planned to give guests the opportunity of shopping in the factory shop. It is possible to organize some glass workshop and blowing activity for smaller groups (to be quoted apart) and let them have the products they produce by themselves.



➤ **Bier trip:**

The town Pilsner is located approximately 70 km from Prague, which is about 50 minutes drive by bus.

Tours of the Pilsner Urquell brewery include a visit to the brew-house, the historic cellars, the modern brewery, and a video-projection about the most famous Czech brewery of them all. The tours conclude in the gift shops, where there is a wide range of souvenir and Pilsner Beer. Along with a brewery tour, the Pilsner Urquell Beer World offers visitors the chance of tasting 12 % beer Pilsner Urquell.

➤ **Trabant race:**

We offer funny race in the city street with, old-fashion communists cars, with famous "Trabant".

The guests are dividing into the small groups of 4-5 pax. Each team receives own car, map of Prague and instructions. The point is to find five checkpoints in the city. Once they reach the



checkpoint the teams have to solve problem and tasks, change the gear, to load baggage etc. The race is measured; there can be only one best Trabant team?
