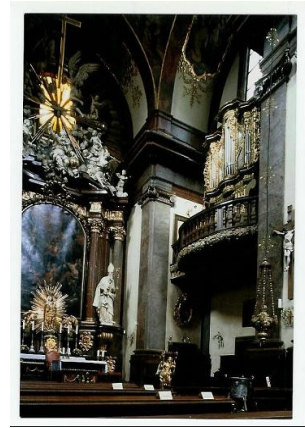


St. Francis of Assisi Church Prague
Summer 2009 Season : 01.04. – 31.10. 2009



- **St. Francis of Assisi Church** conceals the unique baroque organ made in 1702 - **the second oldest organ in Prague**. Series of famous personalities, for example W.A. Mozart, A. Dvořák, J. F. N. Seger and others played the renowned music instrument, at present sensibly restored.
- The church – located **in the very heart of Prague right next to the Charles Bridge**, is **outstanding baroque monument** and together with sound of the organ creates exceptionally coherent tableau of the baroque period. The combination of the brilliant music and art of old master builders offers valuable cultural experiences for every listener.
- The musicians conduct at the organ choir, that's unusually located to the right next to the main altar. It causes **uncustomed visual experiences**, but mainly **uncommon acoustics effects** originate by cross – type floor plan solution of the main nave.
- **The flourishes of welcome performed by two trumpeters in stylized costumes** have been already traditional surprise for our listeners. The flourishes are played the heraldic trumpets for time of thirty minutes before beginning of every concert on staircase of St. Francis of Assisi Church
